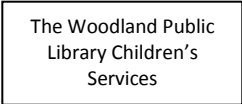
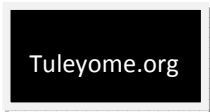

PARENT/GUARDIAN AGREEMENT, WAIVER & RELEASE

In consideration of the minor being permitted to participate in the **Yolo County Youth Leaders “Let’s Get It Started” kick off event** and conference series, I hereby waive, release and discharge any and all claims for damages for personal injury, death or property damage which said minor may sustain or which may occur as a result of the minor's participation in said activity. This release discharges in advance the Yolo County Youth Leaders “Let’s Get It Started” partners (Woodland Community College, Yolo County Office of Education, Woodland Joint Unified School District, Tuleyome, Yolo Family Resource Center, REACH Program of Sierra Health Foundation, Yolo County Alcohol, Drug and Mental Health-Prevention Programs and Yolo County Friday Night Live) their officers, employees, agents or partners from and against any and all liability arising out of or connected in any way with the participation of the minor in said activity, even though that liability may arise out of negligence or carelessness on the part of said event (or its officers, employees, agents or partners). I also certify that, to the best of my knowledge and belief, my son/daughter is in good physical condition and hereby release the above mentioned agencies from any liability. I authorize the physician contacted by the Yolo County Youth Leaders “Let’s Get It Started” staff to provide medical or surgical care, including transportation for my son/daughter, should an emergency occur while attending Yolo County Youth Leaders “Let’s Get It Started.”
